




**TITLE:** Excluded and/or Ineligible Populations

**PURPOSE:** To describe Medicaid Recipients who are not eligible to enroll in First Coast Advantage.

- PROCEDURE:**
1. Revised 9/1/06: Medicaid Recipients who are members of the Florida Assertive Community Treatment Team (FACT Team)  
**Revised 9/1/09: unless they disenroll from the FACT team. These recipients are allowed to enroll in non-Reform PSNs.**
  2. Revised 7/23/08: Women enrolled in the plan that change eligibility categories to the SOBRA eligibility category due to the pregnancy will remain eligible for enrollment in the plan.
  3. Medicaid Recipients who, at the time of application for Enrollment and/or at the time of Enrollment, are domiciled or residing in an institution, including nursing facilities (and have been CARES assessed), statewide inpatient psychiatric (SIPP) facility for individuals under the age of 21, or an Intermediate Care Facility/Developmentally Disabled (ICF-DD), **Revised 9/1/09: or a state mental health hospital or correctional facility.**
  4. Medicaid Recipients whose Medicaid eligibility was determined through the medically needy program
  5. Qualified Medicare Beneficiaries ("QMBs"), Special Low Income Medicare Beneficiaries (SLMBs), or Qualified Individuals at Level 1 (QI-1s)
  6. Medicaid Recipients who have other creditable health-care coverage, such as TriCare or a private health maintenance organization (HMO)
  7. Medicaid Recipients who reside in the following:
    - a. Residential commitment programs/facilities operated through the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ)
    - b. Residential group care operated by the Family Safety & Preservation Program of the DCF
    - c. Children's residential treatment facilities purchased through the Substance Abuse & Mental Health District ("SAMH") Offices of the DCF (also referred to as Purchased Residential Treatment Services - "PRTS")
    - d. SAMH residential treatment facilities licensed as Level I and Level II facilities
    - e. Residential Level I and Level II substance abuse treatment programs. Revised 9/1/09: (See ss. 65D-30.007(2)(a) and (b), F.A.C.);



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8. Medicaid Recipients participating in the Family Planning waiver
  9. Title XXI-funded children with chronic conditions who are enrolled in Children's Medical Services Network
  10. Women eligible for Medicaid due to breast and/or cervical cancer
  11. Individuals eligible under a hospice-related eligibility group  
**Revised 9/1/09: or receiving hospice services.**
  12. **Revised 9/1/09: Individuals enrolled in the Nursing Home Diversion Program or the Program of All Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE).**
