SUBJECT: 837 4010A1 CLAIMS SUBMISSION

DATE: OCTOBER 4, 2007

The week of October 15th, 2007 SummaCare/Apex will be upgrading their EDI system. All claim files received will be held until October 22st, 2007. Once these files are processed the USM files will be made available to you, in the same format as they are today. At that time SummaCare/Apex will begin making 997's available for all claims received through the standard connections. The 997 will parse all claims into individual ST loops and any claim that is found to be non-HIPAA compliant will be rejected and not loaded into our system.

NOTE: The non-HIPAA complaint claims in the 997 will not be loaded for payment into the system and will not be found for review of any type since the data could not be loaded.
