Subject: REMINDER: Florida Medicaid/ First Coast Advantage Timeline 5010 Implementation for Electronic Claims submission.

Date: December 14, 2011

Mandated Implementation by Medicaid and First Coast Advantage for 5010 electronic claims is **January 1, 2012**. First Coast Advantage and Medicaid will no longer accept the 4010 version after January 1, 2012. **All electronic claims submitted January 1, 2012 and after will be denied if not submitted in the correct 5010 version.**

The 5010 version of the claims transactions will no longer allow Providers to include the Medicaid Provider number as part of the transaction and will allow only the NPI. This affects only electronic claims. Consequently, in preparation for the 5010 implementation, Florida Medicaid will no longer accept X12 claim transactions that contain the Florida Medicaid ID Number. **Electronic claims that contain the Medicaid Provider ID Number will be denied.**

First Coast Advantage request that every Provider who is ready to submit electronic claims in the 5010 version begin submitting them immediately to FCA. Medicaid is ready to accept the 5010 version today.

Providers should pay close attention to the changes between the 4010 version and the 5010 version to ensure all updates have been made and the information that is required is being submitted. First Coast Advantage will not alter the electronic claims to convert them to a valid 5010 version.
